

Compound

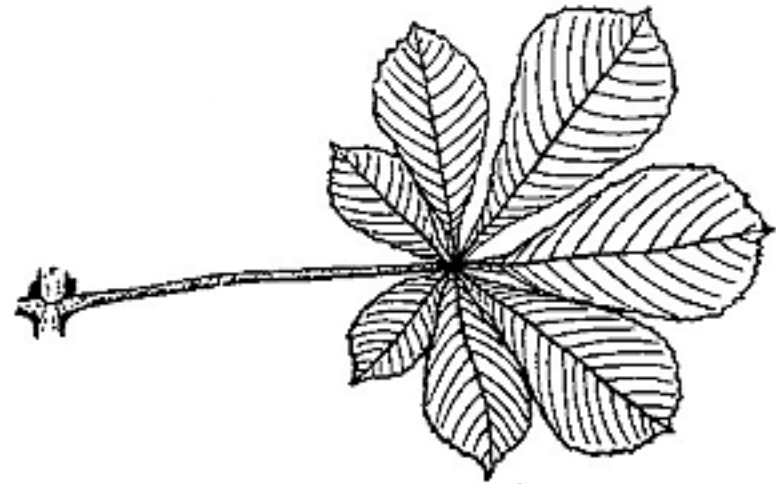
If the leaflets of a compound leaf all radiate from one point, the leaf is palmately compound. If the leaf has a central axis along which leaflets are attached, the leaf is pinnately compound. The axis of a pinnately compound leaf is termed the “rachis.”
